## **BOLLINGTON TOWN COUNCIL**

In addition, each year in March, there is a public meeting in the Civic Hall, when you have the chance to meet Councillors and air your views.

## **BOLLINGTON - THE HAPPY VALLEY**

It is easy to fall in love with Bollington. It is a special place with much to offer. Its situation in the valley of the River Dean on the edge of the Peak District National Park means that you won't have far to walk to join one of the many footpaths surrounding the town. These can take you either on a long strenuous walk lasting several hours, or if you don't feel particularly fit or energetic, you can choose a leisurely, easy stroll along the canal towpath or Middlewood Way, which was once the railway. Either way you will enjoy the sight of the beautiful rolling hills and plains of Cheshire.

One of the best points from which to view Bollington is the top of Kerridge Hill, where Bollington's most famous landmark, the white cone shaped building known as "White Nancy", stands. This monument can be seen from virtually anywhere in Bollington, and has become a much-loved symbol of the town. It was erected by the Gaskell family of Ingersley Hall early in 1817, reputedly to commemorate the Battle of Waterloo in 1815. It was once possible to enter the building and see the large stone slab inside, but because of vandalism, the door has long since been built up.

The quick increase in population was due completely to the Industrial Revolution. The required humidity made Bollington a most suitable place for cotton spinning and the River Dean provided water power. There were many stone quarries surrounding the village with plenty of building materials for the mills and cottages for the workers. Two brothers, Peter and Elias Lomas recognised the potential, took over an old building and founded what was to become the world famous firm of Messrs. Thomas Oliver and Sons Ltd. (Thomas Oliver married Mary Lomas and took over the mill). By the turn of the 18th Century, the Olivers had built Waterhouse Mill (on the present site of Kay Metzeler), and in the early 1800s Lowerhouse Mill was used for the purpose of spinning cotton by George Antrobus and his brother. This factory stood empty for some reason by 1829.

The Macclesfield Canal was opened in 1831 and resulted in the transportation of cotton and stone much more economically. Clarence Mill was built beside the Canal and by 1840 was a flourishing concern under the direction of Mr Brooks and Mr Swindells. The Adelphi Mill was built in 1856 again next to the canal, emphasising the early dependence upon it. Higher and Lower Mills were built at the bottom of Church Street and a Mr Samuel Greg, whose father built Quarry Bank Mill at Styal, acquired Lowerhouse Mill in 1832.

Work in the mills was without doubt hard, but the conditions for the Bollington cotton workers were better than for most other mill workers at the time. Samuel Greg, an idealist, was a well educated and well travelled man, who had picked up some philanthropic ideas on the continent, and wanted to create the perfect society at Lowerhouse. He provided playrooms for the children at the mill, as well as a school and reading room. His workers also enjoyed one family, one house and the dwellings even had gardens, where vegetables and flowers could be grown. Greg called Bollington "Goldenthal" - a German phrase loosely translated as "Happy Valley", a name by which Bollington is still known.

His example of treating his workers well was copied by other mill owners in Bollington. The Greg family bestowed many gifts to the people of Bollington, for example the Recreation Ground in 1901 and the fountain by Bollington Cross, unveiled in 1904 in memory of Samuel Greg by his wife Mary, daughter Amy and nephew Francis Greg.

The reputation of producing the best cotton in the world meant the industry was flourishing in Bollington for a long time. During the cotton famine in the 1861-64 Civil War in America, some supplies were imported from India and Egypt, but many workers found themselves without work. After the Civil War was over came the best period and a boom until about 1930, when competition from Japan and the Far East started to decline.

There was a temporary recovery during and just after the Second World War until the early 1950's, when there was a recession again and redundancies followed. Waterhouse Mill closed in 1960, Clarence Mill in 1970 and Adelphi Mill in 1974. Although no mills any longer produce cotton, most of them are still in use. The two large mills by the canal, Clarence and Adelphi, were restored after some time of dilapidation, and now house a number of companies, and in the case of Clarence, residential accommodation.

Lowerhouse Mill is currently owned by Slater Harrison & Co. Ltd., producing card and paper. Higher and Lower Mills down Church Street became Shrigley Dyers and Tullis Russell Ltd., respectively, the former having now been replaced with housing. Kay Metzeler Ltd. now prospers where Waterhouse Mill once stood. And so, Bollington is still a buzzing community, with a good number of employers, large and small.

The canal's heyday continued a comparatively short time, only around 40 or 50 years, as in July 1870 the railway line from Bollington to Macclesfield opened.

The opening of the canal and railway not only assisted the industry in the town, but it also changed the leisure habits of its inhabitants. Bollington now linked up with other places in England and, particularly in summer and during the Wakes week, Blackpool and other seaside resorts emerged as sources of great attraction for the people of Bollington. There are still some of the older people of the town, who remember the thrill of standing at the station, all dressed up, waiting for the train bound for the annual visit to the beaches of Blackpool.

Bollington's railway station closed on 3rd January 1970, despite protests, but it happened in line with rail closures in less populous districts where buses and cars abound. However, the disused railway line is now a pleasurable walking, riding and cycling route called the Middlewood Way, and the canal, which is situated in beautiful rural surroundings, offers immense pleasure to boaters and anglers.

Today, at the beginning of the third Millennium, Bollington has around 7,000 inhabitants, a number which is still growing. The town has become a very desirable place to live, and developers are building wherever they are allowed. The "two-up, two-down" cottages, once housing very large families on modest means, have become much sought after properties

The War Memorial is a private war memorial, bought by Kerridge people in 1918 to the memory of their loved ones lost in the great war and now also those of the 1939-45 war. The War Memorial & surrounding gardens are maintained to a high standard by the committee, supported by voluntary subscriptions and donations which are always gratefully received. Annual War Memorial Service and Parade is held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in July at 3.00 pm at the War Memorial, Oak Lane, Kerridge, at which a public collection is taken.
