#### Building a Better Lighttrap: the Square Kilometre Array

Astronomy is based on the detection and analysis of light we receive from objects in the sky. It follows that progress in our understanding of the universe comes through advances in light-detection technology: we continue to build bigger and more sensitive telescopes in order to address challenging problems and discover new phenomena.

The Square Kilometre Array (SKA) represents the next major advance in radio astronomy. Scheduled for construction in the early 2020s, it will be one of the largest scientific projects in the world.—a global partnership of 10 countries, with its international headquarters on the campus at Jodrell Bank.

Professor Gary Davis is an astrophysicist who will describe the world-wide effort to design and build the SKA. Along the way he may well diverge into other topics, depending on how many pints he is given. Talk starts at 6.30pm at the Vale Inn, Adlington Road, Bollington. Arrive in good time to be sure of a seat. All welcome, no charge.
