LOCAL ORGANISED WALKS

The **Bridgend Centre** run regular short, moderate and longer walks taking in points of interest and local history along the way. These graded circular walks start at 10.15am at the Bridgend Centre, 101 Palmerston Street SK10 5PW 01625 576311 and finish back at the centre unless otherwise stated.



Please register at the centre at 10am to ensure a prompt start.
£3 per walk – includes tea, coffee and biscuits at end of walk.

Wednesday 1st August 4 miles	Savio, Oakenbank, Rainowlow, Billinge and Hedgerow. Includes a medium climb from Oakenbank to Rainowlow.
Saturday 4th August *PUBLIC TRANSPORT WALK* 530m of climb and very strenuous. 12 miles	We will get the 10:32 bus to Macclesfield and will return via a 12 mile walk through Macclesfield golf club, Langley, Macclesfield Forest, past Lamaload reservoir and back over the tops to Bollington. The walk is £3 which does not include the bus fare (£2.80). For more information please contact the Bridgend Centre.
Wednesday 8th August 4 miles	Green Lane, Long Lane and the Windmill Pub (Nostalgia Trail 1). A relatively easy walk on country lanes and over fields
Wednesday 15th August 270m of ascent overall. 5.5 miles	Infrequently walked footpaths—a walk designed to seek out some infrequently trodden footpaths in Bollington. One stiff short climb to be taken at a gentle pace.
Wednesday 22nd August 6 miles	Pott Shrigley, Bakestonedale and Harrop Valley. Quite a hilly walk with a few climbs
Wednesday 29th August 5 miles	Savio, Ingersley Vale, Waukmill Wood, Under Nancy and Kerridge
